Competitive Coach – Competitive coaches will be responsible for team management, some choreography, all skills training, and must attend all camps over the summer and competitions during the season. Competitive coaches should have 2 years or more of experience as a cheer team coach, must attend all staff training and master their level tumbling and stunt skills (know all rules and guidelines). There will be 1 head coach per competitive team. Head coaches begin their assignment on May 1st, 2018 and end on April 30, 2019. Head coaches must meet all other obligations assigned.

Prep Coach – Junior coaches must have at least 1 year as a cheerleading coach or CIT. Prep coaches will coach once a week with a prep team. Prep coaches must attend skills training and summer camps. Prep coaches must meet all other obligations assigned.

Class/Rec Coach – Class coaches should have 3-5 years experience in tumbling, cheerleading or other applicable areas. Tumbling certifications are a plus. Class coaches must meet all other obligations assigned.

Camp/Event Instructor – Camp instructors must be FUN! This person should be able to manage up to 10 kids at a time, instruct cheerleading skills, play games, be personable reliable. Camp coaches must meet all other obligations assigned.

Coach in Training (CIT) – CIT's are usually 1st or 2nd year coaches who volunteer as a coach assistant. CIT's are assigned teams and work with coaches during practice. CITs will begin their season in September and work until the end of April. They work once a week with a team or rec class. CIT's must attend a training session in early September.

All coaches must have a Vulnerable Sector Police background check that is no more than 3 years old. All coaches should be CPR or First-Aid certified.
